- Long papers may contain up to 8 pages of content, plus unlimited pages for bibliographic references. Short papers may contain up to 4 pages of content, plus unlimited pages for bibliographic references.
Papers must respect the double-blind review process:
1. In preparing your manuscript, do not include any information which could reveal your identity, or that of your co-authors (including funding details in acknowledgements).
2. Self-references that reveal the author's identity, e.g., "We previously showed (Smith, 1991) ...", should be avoided. Instead, use citations such as "Smith (1991) previously showed ...".
3. Before submitting the PDF file, authors are responsible to check the "Author", "Affiliation", "Description" and other fields in the PDF metadata.
ACL-IJCNLP 2021 will not consider any paper that is under review in a journal or another conference at the time of submission.

Submissions that do not conform to the above requirements will be rejected without review.

If the pseudo-code or derivations or model specifications are an important part of the contribution, or if they are important for the reviewers to assess the technical correctness of the work, they should be a part of the main paper, and not appear in the appendix.
